Thank you for your interest in volunteering with New Gorbals Housing Association.

Our Association was established in 1989 by a group of local people who wanted to provide the people of the Gorbals with high quality, desirable and affordable housing. Over the years we have grown to become the Gorbals largest provider of Social Rented Housing but we have always remained a Community Controlled Housing Association.

We want to support this as much as we can, and so we're delighted to launch a formal volunteering programme that will support, value and reward local people for their contribution to their community.

VOLUNTEERING WITH US

Anyone aged 16+ can volunteer with us. You don't have to be a tenant but you do have to be a Gorbals resident.

Volunteering with us will give you the opportunity to learn more about what we do and influence the services we deliver.

If you choose to volunteer with our Communities Team you will be part of a team of volunteers working to deliver a whole range of services and activities for local people.

You'll go through our informal induction process and learn about our commitment to volunteering as set out in our Volunteer Policy and allocated a Volunteer Support Officer, a member of our Communities Team, who will work with you to make sure you get the most out of volunteering.

As a volunteer you'll be involved in helping to design, develop and deliver the activities you are part of, so you will have the opportunity to really influence what happens in your community.

You will never be out of pocket as we'll cover all of your expenses and, if you need any special equipment or adaptations to help you volunteer we'll cover these too.

We want your volunteering experience to be really positive and satisfying so we'll check in with you regularly to make sure we're meeting our commitment!



OUR OPPORTUNITIES

We currently offer five volunteer opportunities, four of these are supported by our Communities Team with the fifth supported by our Senior Management Team.

COMMUNITY MEAL VOLUNTEER

Community Meal Volunteers will work with our Communities Team to help deliver community meals.

The role is varied and we need people to:

- Help us design menus and create shopping lists
- Shop for ingredients
- Prep and cook meals
- Welcome and engage with diners
- Serve food
- Help clearing and cleaning after meals.

COMMUNITY EVENTS & ACTIVITIES VOLUNTEER


Community Events & Activities Volunteers will work with our Communities Team to help deliver a whole range of events and activities including the Gorbals Fair, Christmas Lights Switch On, Halloween Events etc.

The role will include:

- Management to make sure each part of the event is properly organised and runs smoothly;
- Promoting events across the community;
- Hosting events and activities, welcoming and engaging with participants.







OUR OPPORTUNITIES

GORBALS IDEAS FUND COMMUNITY ADVOCATE

The Gorbals Ideas Fund is a community-led initiative that brings Participatory Budgeting to the Gorbals. Working with our Community Budgeting Officer voluteers act as Community Advocates to:

- Encourage, educate and empower local people to improve outcomes for themselves and their community;
- Advocate for and on behalf of the wider community to ensure their experiences, views and opinions are considered at all levels of decision making; and
- deliver Participatory Budgeting processes that give local people control over how local funds are spent to address local priorities.

TENANT PARTICIPATION PANEL MEMBER

If you are a New Gorbals Housing Association tenant you can join our Tenant Participation Panel.

The Panel meets on a quarterly basis and helps us think about the best ways to keep our tenants informed and included in our work.

As a Panel member you'll help us to continually improve our services by sharing your views, experiences and opinions.

As a Community Controlled Housing Association we rely on our tenants to help guide our work.
