Join NGHA for just £1 for lifetime membership and have your say over how the Association runs. This leaflet details all the benefits of becoming a member and how you can help us do the best for the people of Gorbals.

What does it mean to be a member of NGHA?

NGHA is a community-controlled housing association. This means the people of Gorbals who join the Association as members govern the Association, with control over key decisions and strategy.

Anyone over 16 who lives in Gorbals can apply to become a member. The membership fee is a one-off payment of £1 which means you become a lifetime shareholder (although there is no return on your share).

Members get a vote at the AGM and can stand to be on the Management Committee, the group responsible for taking key decisions on how NGHA operates.

As a member, you get to have a say in your local community, give your views on the services you receive and help to shape and improve the services NGHA offers.

What does membership entitle you to?

- Become a lifetime shareholder
- Attend our Annual General Meeting (AGM) and any Special General Meetings
- Vote on any relevant matters as well as the election of members to serve on our Committee
- Stand for election to the Management Committee yourself, or nominate other members for election
